### Emiliana Chardonnay, Central Valley (CH)

Exotic tropical fruit aromas of passion fruit and bananas followed by and intense mouthful of a lively fruit cocktail; quite full and pure flavours matched by a crisp acidity to finish.

### Swallows' Tale Sauvignon Blanc Chenin, Robertson (SA)

Ripe and concentrated, floral and peach tones, green apples, tropical fruit and a finish of green fig, Perfect accompaniment to most seafood dishes and poultry.

### Macabeo, Casa Carmela, Yecla (ESP)

A charming young wine bursting with exuberant ripe tropical fruits and a rounded finish.

The blending of these two grapes creates and enjoyable everyday drinking wine offering intense aromas of citrus and tropical fruit flavours.

A fresh, citric style of Sauvignon offering notes of grapefruit and elderflower on a zesty uplifting palate.

Combining the zesty straw aromas of Semillon and the softer peach notes of Chardonnay, the creamy palate offers hints of vanilla from the short time spent on oak to add some complexity to this appealing white.

### Walnut Block Organic Sauvignon Blanc 'Collectables', Marlborough (NZ)

Lively; showing intense aromas of melon, citrus and passion fruit. Extended lees ageing has created a rich and finely textured palate with great fruit intensity. Beautifully ripe and vividly fresh with a crisp, pure finish.

### Croix des Vents Syrah Rosé, IGP Pays d'Oc, Languedoc (FR)

Deep, rich and bright colour. Luxurious, intense bouquet with strawberries and raspberries. Fresh, delicate mouth is well balanced with good acidity.

### 9-Emiliana Merlot, Central Valley (CH)

Beautiful violet-purple colour, characterised by its fruitiness and rich varietal aromas. Medium bodied with soft notes of violets, plum and berries on palate; vanilla and mocha appear on long finish.

### Swallows' Tale Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon, Robertson (SA)

Dark ruby with youthful blackberry and ripe berried fruits. Young and vibrant with elegant upfront fruit ending with a touch of peppery spice. Strongly recommended.

## Main List

### Monastrell, Casa Carmela, Yecla (ESP)

A medium to full-bodied wine with generous savoury loganberry and forest fruits and a dry smooth finish.

### Hooded Plover Shiraz, NSW (AUS)

Vibrant with a lifted dark nose, complemented with hints of spicy pepper and liquorice. Smooth palate with soft supple tannins that culminate in a rich ripe finish.

### Eco Organic Pinot Noir, Bio Bio Valley (CH)

Aromas of berries, sweet vanilla and soft, floral notes. The palate is fruity with a velvety texture: medium structure with an intense finish.

### Main à Main Cabernet Sauvignon Pays d'Oc, Languedoc (FR)

Very French style of Cabernet with elegant clean blackcurrant fruits and light tannins to provide balance and a dry finish.

### Renacer Punto Final Malbec Classico, Luján de Cuyo (ARG)

Aromas of marinated meat, plum and blackberry. Saturated heavy and modern upfront fruit – fully ripened and beautifully structured.

### Crianza, Bodegas Ramón Bilbao, Rioja (ESP)

This plush, modern red frames black cherry flavours with tobacco and dark chocolate notes and should please almost anyone with a taste for Spanish reds.

# Fine Wine Selection

## White

### Chablis, William Fèvre (FR)

Pale gold with hints of green; refined bouquet of citrus and white flowers entwined with a light mineral touch. Fresh, rich mouth balanced by good freshness.

### Pouilly-Fuissé, Bouchard Père et Fils (FR)

Pale gold with green hues; deep nose developing flavours of ripe fruit (pear and citrus); perfectly balanced mouth, both fresh and silky.

### Larry Cherubino Ad Hoc 'Hen & Chicken' Chardonnay, Pemberton (AUS)

Aromas of melon, citrus and minerals follow through on palate. Creamy mouthfeel with generous palate structure and clean acid backbone. Complex flavour profile with stonefruit, melon and citrus complemented by savoury minerality and toasty nuttiness. A long clean finish.

### Chassagne-Montrachet, Bouchard Père et Fils (FR)

Intense floral and fruit aromas. Full bodied yet smooth, this wine has excellent length.

Good ageing potential. Perfect with starters, creamed fish and white meat in cream sauce.

## Red

### Chianti Classico, Badia a Coltibuono, Tuscany (IT)

Intense ruby red, aromas of a cherry, tobacco, vanilla hint of spices violets and leather. Pleasantly lingering dry flavour with well balanced tannins and good acidity.

### Fleurie La Réserve, Villa Ponciago, Burgundy (FR)

Fine, elegant nose developing notes of cherry and blueberry followed by violets and peonies. An expressive palate with freshness highlighting balanced between structure and aromatic richness.

### Château de Seuil Graves Rouge, Bordeaux (FR)

2006 was a very good vintage at du Seuil. The wine has many of the characteristics of a classic Bordeaux vintage. Good acidity, concentrated, forward tannins and a complex fruitiness. Multiple levels of structure and integrated oak flavours.

### Châteauneuf du Pape Rouge, Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Chante Cigale, Rhône (FR)

Underlining the effect of the 'galets roulés' of Chateauneuf on old vines; deep colour and pronounced body balanced by the roundness of the Grenache and a lingering finish.

Bright yellow straw colour with greenish hints and intense, fruity bouquet; fresh, harmonious palate. Enjoy as an aperitif or with food.
