- 4. Graham Beck Waterside Chardonnay** South Africa 18.85
An unoaked Chardonnay with pale straw colour and exotic fruit on the nose. wonderful fresh lime mixed with tropical zestiness on the nose. Good firm acidity on the palate with lots of citrus, melon and grapefruit flavours.
- 5. Vanidade Albarino** Spain 21.85
Bone dry with high acidity and lively flavours of crisp green apple, peach and citrus. A simple and fresh style, wonderful as an apperitif or delicious with fish or salads.
- 6. Moreau Sauvignon Blanc** France 23.85
Gooseberries and herbacious aromas with citrus and grapefruit flavours. The acidity is well balanced and the finish is refreshing and clean.
- 8. Font Mars Picpoul** France 21.85
Lively crisp and dry white from the south of France, notes of white peach and pineapple great as an aperitif or with seafood.
- 9. Hugel Alsace Gentil** France 25.85
Spicy, floral-scented (a blend of Alsace's traditional varieties) exhibits a light to medium-bodied, boisterous, rich personality. Loads of spice and pears can be found in this simple, delicious white.
- 10. Matua Valley Sauvignon Blanc** New Zealand 22.85
A crisp, medium bodied, dry wine bursting with flavours of passionfruit, blackcurrant and gooseberry. Mouth-watering acidity is balanced by a long, elegant, mineral finish.
- 11. Chapoutier Crozes Hermitage blanc 'La Petit Ruche'** France 25.85
Pale yellow with a greenish tint, limpid & brilliant. First nose a sour apple with a strong floury bouquet, supple and very fresh.
- 12. The Wolftrap** Franschhoek, South Africa 26.85
A spicy aromatic white blend of Chenin Blanc, Viognier and Grenache blanc - French oak matured.
- 13. Domaine de la Chauviniere Muscadet** France 26.85
Elegant and fruity with flavours reminiscent of white flowers and citrus fruits.

- 51. Graham Beck Brut** South Africa 29.85
A stunning South African 'Méthode Cap Classique' with the same double fermentation method as used in Champagne. Nelson Mandela served it at his Presidential inauguration in 1994 and Barack Obama poured the same at his inauguration in 2008.
- 52. Prosecco Conti d'Arco** Italy 25.85
Defined bouquet of glaze fruits and sweet smelling flowers lively foam. Clean and gentle with natural sugar and long aromatic after taste.
- 53. Mumm Champagne** France 69.85
A true classic with a unique character and irreproachably consistent taste. It has a soft, round biscuity style.

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| 24. San Medin Cabernet | Chile | 16.85 |
| Full bodied rich red with spicy, licorice, blackcurrant and vanilla notes. A classic Cabernet from a legendary winemaker. | | |
| 25. 'La Ciboise' M.Chapoutier | France | 23.85 |
| Ruby colour, with a nose and palate of soft cherry fruit and spice. Excellent with grilled or roast meat. | | |
| 26. Ibericos Rioja | Spain | 24.85 |
| Notes of forest fruits, blueberries and blackberries balanced with toasted notes from the wood, smooth tannins and fine fruity sensations. | | |
| 27. Moreau Pinot Noir | France | 21.85 |
| Aromas of cherry and coffee beans with subtle, well-integrated oak. Delectable on the palate, fruity and toasted boasting good power. | | |
| 28 Wakefield Estate Shiraz | Australia | 25.85 |
| Rich, luscious and round with intense, ripened fruit characters. Mocha coffee and subtle spice characters complement generous fruit flavours of plum and blackberry. | | |
| 29. Chateau de la Ligne | France | 26.85 |
| Classic blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, delicate nose of gooseberries and blackberries soft round tannins and notes of oak. | | |
| 30. The Wolftrap | South Africa | 26.85 |
| A spicy aromatic red blend of Syrah, Mourvedre and Voignier - French oak matured. | | |
| 31. Chateau Magnol Ht Medoc | France | 39.85 |
| Deep red with a ruby shade. A very expressive nose full of red berry aromas as well as toasty and minty notes. Good concentration with soft tannins and a long fruity and spicy finish. | | |
| 32. St Emilion Thomas Barton | France | 31.85 |
| A classic Saint Emilion wine with velvety tannins and a long fruity finish with a touch of oak. Intense ruby red with blueberry and cherry aromas and a delicate peppery and toasty notes appearing when agitated. | | |

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| 41. Moreau Rose d' Anjou | France | 17.85 |
| Lively fruity rosé wine with lots of strawberry fruit on the nose and an attractive crisp sweetness on the palate. | | |

Dessert wine
